



Cookie policy of the website of **Holm Bank AS**

What is a cookie used on a website?

A cookie is a small text file which includes the information required for the online server to recognise a user. The information is used to record your visits and preferences on our website (the website of Holm Bank AS and the subpages thereof). Holm Bank AS collects cookies with an aim to improve the website and develop the service through user experience – using cookies makes browsing our website smoother and provides us statistical data about visits to our site. Only cookies which you have ‘accepted’ can read the text file.

The text file is not harmful, does not include viruses or codes, and cannot be associated with a specific person or the IP address of their device. Cookies do not collect any information about the users and the server cannot access the cookies of any other websites or any other information in your device.

Which cookies are used by Holm Bank AS?

Holm Bank AS uses two types of cookies: permanent and session cookies. These differ by their storage time.

Session cookies – only saved in the user’s device for the duration of the visit to our website and removed upon closing the web browser.

Permanent cookies – saved in the user’s device for a certain period.

How to reject cookies?

If you object to the use of cookies in your devices, you can change the privacy settings of your browser at any time and delete the cookies which have been saved in your device. You should, however, keep in mind that all websites may not function properly if you have blocked all cookies.
